

## Red Wines

**1. Siete Soles Cabernet Sauvignon Chile €19.50**

A well balanced red wine with plenty of fruit, good body, supple tannins and a long aftertaste

**2. Fortius Tempranillo Spain €21.00**

Made from the Tempranillo grape, this lovely red wine offers a well balanced mix of dark fruit, vanilla from oak ageing and a little toast like spice with good length. A must try for Rioja lovers.

**3. Stony Cape Cabernet/Cinsault S. Africa €21.00**

The fruity and silky smoothness of the Cinsault, complimented by the robust and complex Ruby-Cabernet produces this harmonious wine.

**4. Malle Point Shiraz Australia €21.00**

A full bodied shiraz that shows generous ripe fruit characters, a touch of vanillin oak and soft, long and enjoyable finish.

**5. Finca Simonassi Malbec Argentina €21.00**

Lovely supple smooth red wine. Sweetly ripe and flavour rich

**6. Terra Andina Merlot Chile €22.00**

Smooth Chilean Merlot whose plummy flavours and long after taste are perfect with red meats.

**7. River Garden Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon S. Africa €22.50**

Deep red colour with a subtle combination of blackcurrant fruit, peach and light mint aromas. The palate is described as elegant yet firm, with dry tannins and an adequate level of acidity.

**8. Marcesini Chianti DOCG Italy €25.00**

Bright ruby red colour tending towards garnet as it ages, almond nose. This is a dry, harmonious, pungent flavoured wine that becomes soft and velvety on the finish.

**9. Barton & Guestier Cotes du Rhone France €24.50**

A medium rich fruity red with a little liquorice like spice that is made by an historic company started by Irishman Thomas Barton in France in 1725.

**10. Thomas Barton St Emilion France €28.50**

Classic St Emilion with intense fruity aromas, supple texture and good length that goes well with a wide range of dishes.

## White Wines

**11. Siete Soles Sauvignon Blanc Chile €19.50**

A crisp and intense Sauvignon Blanc with fresh acidity and a rich and long aftertaste.

**12. Muller Five Star Riesling Germany €19.50**

German wine made in the New World style. Very attractive floral aromas with mineral tones on the nose followed by a mid-weight, off-dry palate showing clear, pure fruit and fresh, cleansing acidity. Nice.

**13. Andreas Cava Chardonnay Argentina €21.00**

An excellent Chardonnay from the well known San Rafael region of Argentina. Fresh melon and mandarin on the nose with just a hint of rose petals. Fresh palate with clean acidity balanced by melon and kiwi fruit.

**14. Malle Point Chardonnay Australia €21.00**

A wonderful modern Australian Chardonnay with inviting melon and peach fruit with just a touch of oak acting as seasoning.

**15. Stony Cape Chenin Blanc S. Africa €21.00**

This vibrant and zesty Chenin Blanc has a lovely citrus and peach nose, with an elegant and smooth palate.

**16. River Garden Sauvignon Blanc S. Africa €22.50**

Well balanced sauvignon blanc with lime aromas and tropical fruit flavours.

**17. Fattori Pinot Grigio Italy €24.00**

Crisp, fresh and apples and melons fruity flavours with a long and enjoyable after taste.

**18. Cotes du Rhone Caves St Pierre White France €24.50**

Fresh, lively, white Cotes du Rhone featuring expressive stone fruit aromas and flavours of peach and apricot with medium body and refreshing palate.

**19. Couronne et Lions Rose d'Anjou France €21.00**

Intensely fruity off dry wine with raspberries and redcurrant fruits, yet a lively fresh character and a long aftertaste.

**20. Il Cortigiano Prosecco Spumante Italy €27.00**

Youthful and fresh Italian sparkling wine with delicate fragrance and flavours of pear and stone fruits.
